



BRIAN BRODERSEN is the associate pastor of Calvary Chapel Costa Mesa, California. Brian has been involved in missions work and church planting for more than 25 years.



TERRY ASCOTT has lived in the Middle East and served as the leader for indigenous media ministries for more than 30 years. In 1973 Terry moved to Beirut, Lebanon and worked to launch an Arabic Christian publishing ministry. After the start of the Lebanese Civil War, Terry and his family evacuated to Egypt. In Egypt, Terry launched an Arabic youth magazine called *Magalla*. This was the first Christian magazine to be successfully distributed on Egyptian newsstands. In 1995 he, along with Middle Eastern Christian leaders and around twenty partner organizations working in the region, launched SAT-7, the first Arabic Christian satellite television channel. He and his wife, Jacqueline, live in Nicosia, Cyprus.



DANIEL MASSIEH was born in Egypt into a Muslim family. In his early adult life he was curious about what happened in Christian churches, being sure they did something terribly wrong. While visiting a church with the intent to find fault, he was touched by the Lord and brought to faith in Jesus Christ. He was imprisoned for his faith and severely abused, but boldly shared the gospel with his captors and was eventually released. After some time of ministry in Egypt he immigrated to the U.S. where he has faithfully served the Lord as a pastor and Bible teacher.



TIM ANDERSON has been involved with the Calvary Chapel Movement since 1982. He was ordained at Calvary Chapel Santa Barbara in 1990. The Anderson family then served during the 90s as missionaries in Eastern Europe following the collapse of communism. In July 2001 they answered a call to pastor at Calvary Chapel Burbank. Tim and his wife, Laura, have been married 24 years and have five children.



PAUL BILLINGS and his wife, Melanie, moved from the Ukraine to the predominantly Muslim country of Kyrgyzstan where they planted the first Calvary Chapel in Central Asia. Paul pastors in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan.



MELANIE BILLINGS has been involved in missions since her family moved to Ukraine in 1992 and planted Calvary Chapel Kiev. While ministering in Ukraine she met Paul, and soon after their marriage, moved to Kyrgyzstan. Melanie currently helps lead the music ministry in CC Bishkek, while also raising her five children.



BOB CALDWELL is the pastor of Calvary Chapel of Boise.
